Position: PhD-candidate in an SNSF project (100% SNF position)

### Exigencies:

The successful candidate should hold an MA degree in Linguistics (or an equivalent degree), have experience in the linguistic analysis of French, and be motivated to develop an original PhD thesis project within the framework of a Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) funded research project on French grammar-in-interaction. The research project is coordinated with international partners working on Hebrew, Swedish, and Estonian. Experience in conversation analysis or Interactional Linguistics represent further assets, and so does knowledge of one of the above languages.

### Tasks:

Work on a PhD thesis within the abovementioned project, participate in the teaching and research activities of the Centre for Applied Linguistics and in doctoral schools.

### Remuneration:

Legal (CHF 47'886.60 per year according to the SNF salary scheme, with yearly increase).

**Start of position:** October 1, 2023, or upon agreement.

**Duration:** 4 years.
