Position: Post-doctoral researcher in an SNSF project (70% SNF position)

Exigencies:

PhD in linguistics, knowledge of the linguistic system of French, mastery of conversation analysis, motivation to carry out an original research project within the framework of a project (funded by the Swiss National Science Foundation, SNSF) on grammar-in-interaction in French, with a particular focus on adverbial clauses and issues of subordination/insubordination. The project is coordinated internationally with partners working on Hebrew, Swedish and Estonian. Knowledge of one of these languages and/or training in language typology would represent additional assets.

Tasks:

Development of personal research, collaboration with the team of the abovementioned project, participation in the teaching and research activities of the Centre for Applied Linguistics.

Remuneration:

Legal (CHF 63'261.- per year according to the SNF salary scheme (Post doc 70%), with yearly increase).

Start of position: October 1, 2023, or upon agreement.

Duration: 4 years.
